

II EUROPEAN GAMES



From 21 to 30 June 2019, the Republic of Belarus will host the II European Games - international integrated sports competitions among athletes of the European continent, which are held every four years under the leadership of the European Olympic Committees.

In the framework of the II European Games medals will be played in 15 sports. Competitions in 8 sports will become qualifying for the XXXII Olympic Games 2020 in Tokyo. Competitions in boxing and judo will be held in the rank of the European Championships.

During the Games, it is expected that about 4 thousand athletes, about 2 thousand coaches and support staff will arrive in the Belarusian capital. They will present official delegations from 50 European National Olympic Committees. The competition will be served by about 650 international as well as 410 national sports judges. In Minsk, more than 1,000 foreign media representatives, 100 presidents, general secretaries of European sports federations and sports ministers of European countries, more than 250 representatives and employees of the EOC headquarters, presidents and general secretaries of European NOCs, 200 guests of European NOCs, as well as presidents are expected, prime ministers and dignitaries of European states. The event will involve about 8 thousand volunteers.

The competitions of the II European Games 2019 will be held at the largest sports facilities in Minsk, including the Dynamo Stadium, Minsk-Arena, Chizhovka-Arena.

For 10 days, from 21 to 30 June 2019, athletes will compete for 200 sets of medals.
